Awana is finished until next October. Thank you so much to Jon and Melissa Erickson and their team for all their hard work!



We are a non-profit women's health organization that helps women facing an unplanned pregnancy, in the time of crisis when a life or death decision of abortion is made. We are supported by "Everyday Heroes as volunteers, partner donors, churches, and businesses, who partner with MPS to extend the gift of HOPE.

Our BestOptions services are free of charge to the women in our community and include:

- Free Pregnancy test and confirming ultrasound. (over 90% will choose life if they see and ultrasound
- Mentoring for women in the LifePlan as well as the fathers, to earn baby bucks for baby supplies
- NEW 2017 Free STD testing and treatment for women. Muskegon ranks 3<sup>r</sup> in the State for STD diseases!
- NEW 2017 We are offering to church youth groups a Pizza Party with a 30 minute education and preventative presentation regarding (SRA) Sexual Risk Avoidance = Abstinence and God's design for marriage. We believe that education and preventative programs are key to reaching the next generation.
